If you are staying at Chautauqua Suites, it is suggested that you pick up your Gate tickets before you come to the hotel. Estimate your arrival and departure times at Chautauqua Institution when selecting gate ticket fees below. Most of the attendees will select the Afternoon/Evening (noon to midnight). The members who go to 2 rehearsals & sing in the Chautauqua Choir in the amphitheater will receive the Afternoon ticket (noon to 8 p.m. only)
